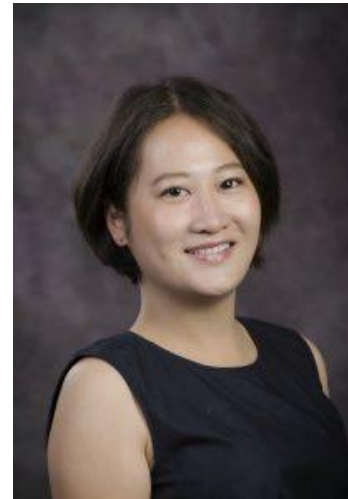

## CNR Research Highlights 2020-2021

- 284 proposals submitted, \$71M (+6%, +29%)
- Received 138 new awards, \$15.3M (-9%, +35%)
- 32 collaborative awards (\$7.2M) with other colleges
- \$702K in new and renewing memberships across SOFAC and SAFI
- 70% from Federal funding agencies (e.g., NSF, USDA, DOE)
- Total expenditures \$9.9M
  - \$8.1M direct
  - \$1.8M F&A

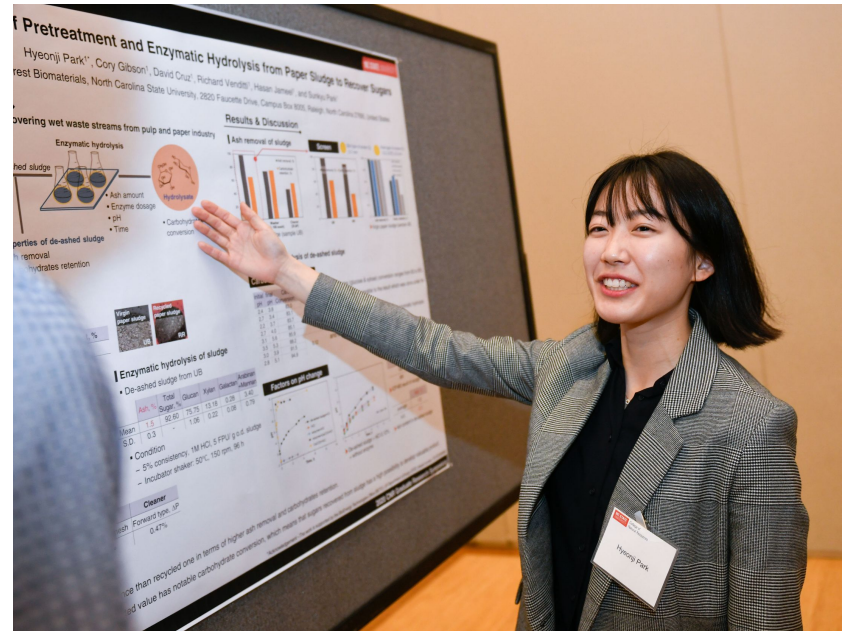
